

Intro to Ringette, Skills Development and House League (Girls under 10)

Intro to Ringette Program:

Come and give ringette a try. The Intro to Ringette program offers a 10-week introduction to ringette for girls 10 years and under who would like to try the game. **Beginners are welcome - no previous skating or ringette experience is required.** Our volunteer coaches and senior level players will provide skating instruction and an opportunity to play with ringette sticks and rings. The ten sessions are designed to help your daughter gain confidence on the ice with an emphasis on having fun.

Equipment: Hockey skates and a CSA approved hockey helmet with mask required to participate.
Sticks and rings provided.

When: Sundays 3:30 – 4:30 p.m Tom Graham Arena.

Skills Development

Let's learn skills. The 20 – week session Skills Development program is designed for girls who have learned to skate and are now ready to learn the skills required to play the game along with the rules.

Beginners are welcome. Our volunteer coaches and senior level players will provide skating and skill instruction to further develop the skills required to play the sport. Emphasis is on having fun.

Equipment: CSA approved hockey helmet & ringette facemask, hockey skates, BNQ approved neck protector, elbow pads, shin pads, hockey gloves, hip/tailbone/genital protection, ringette pants or hockey pants and socks, ringette stick.

When: Sundays 3:30 – 4:30 p.m Tom Graham Arena.
October -March

Cost: \$200

Information and advice on the purchase of ringette equipment will be provided to parents as part of these programs, with the intent that if your daughter is interested, she will be equipped and ready to join our House League program next season. The Intro to Ringette registration fee can be applied to the Skills Development fee on a pro-rated basis.

House League Program:

Let's play ringette. The House League runs once a week from October until March and offers girls an opportunity to play ringette in a local recreational program. Volunteer coaches will teach the girls basic skating and ringette skills. Games/practices are held once a week and some exhibition games with other House League teams may be added to the schedule. Regulation ringette equipment is mandatory to participate in this program (see below).
