Learn-to-Play Ringette and House Leagues (Girls 10 years and under)

Learn-to-Play Ringette Program:

Come and give ringette a try. The Learn-to-Play Ringette program offers a 10-week introduction to ringette for girls 8 years and under who would like to try the game. **Beginners are welcome - no previous skating or ringette experience is required.** Our volunteer coaches and senior level players will provide skating instruction and an opportunity to play with ringette sticks and rings. The ten one-hour sessions are designed to help your daughter gain confidence on the ice with an emphasis on having fun. Information and advice on the purchase of ringette equipment will be provided to parents as part of the program, with the intent that if your daughter is interested, she will be equipped and ready to join our Bunny House League program at the end of the 10-weeks. The Learn-to-Play registration fee can be applied to the Bunny House League fee on a pro-rated basis.

Who: Girls 8 years of age and under (born 2001 or earlier)

Equipment: Hockey skates and a CSA approved hockey helmet with mask required to participate. Sticks and rings provided.

When: Sundays 2:30-3:30 or 3:30 – 4:30 p.m.

Where: Tom Graham Arena (1300 Elgin Mills Rd. East at Leslie St.)

Cost: \$100

House League Programs:

Let's play ringette. The House League runs once a week from October until March and offers girls 10 years and under an opportunity to play ringette in a local recreational program. Volunteer coaches will teach the girls basic skating and ringette skills. Games/practices are held once a week and some exhibition games with other House League teams may be added to the schedule. **Beginners are welcome - no previous skating or ringette experience is required.** Regulation ringette equipment is mandatory to participate in this program (see below).

Who: Girls 10 years of age and under.

Equipment: CSA approved hockey helmet & ringette facemask, hockey skates, BNQ approved neck protector, elbow pads, shin pads, hockey gloves, hip/tailbone/genital protection, ringette pants or hockey pants and socks, ringette stick.

Bunny House League (age 7 and under)

When: Sundays 3:30 – 4:30 p.m. from October – March

Where: Tom Graham Arena

Cost: \$190

Novice House League (age 8 to 10)

When: Saturdays 4:30-5:30 p.m. From October – March

Where: Elgin Barrow Arena

Cost: \$265
